

Placement Bursaries

- How long will the Bursary Program be available?

The program will be running throughout 2021 Semester 2 from 9th August 2021 (Week 2) to 30th October 2021 (Week 12).

- Basic Eligibility Requirements

To apply for a UQU Placement Bursary you must be:

- a) A current enrolled UQ student (undergraduate or postgraduate)
- b) Undertaking a placement in Semester 2, 2021
- c) Experiencing extenuating circumstances that will impact your ability to have financial stability during your placement. This may include, but is not limited to, the following: reduced work hours, having a disability that will make it difficult to work and engage in placement simultaneously, and/or having to relocate to complete the placement.
- d) Able to provide evidence to build a case to show that you will experience, are experiencing or have experienced financial hardship due to the placement.

- What documents do I need to provide?

1. Employed

- Letter of Placement
- 3 months of Bank Statement
- Proof of identification – UQ Student Card and either your passport or Driver's Licence
- 2 most recent payslips

2. Employed and Receiving Centrelink

- Letter of Placement
- 3 months of Bank Statement
- Proof of identification – UQ Student Card and either your passport or Driver's Licence
- 2 most recent payslips
- Centrelink Statement of Income

3. Unemployed

- Letter of Placement
 - 3 months of Bank Statement
 - Proof of identification – UQ Student Card and either your passport or Driver’s Licence
4. Unemployed and receiving Centrelink
- Letter of Placement
 - 3 months of Bank Statement
 - Proof of identification – UQ Student Card and either your passport or Driver’s Licence
 - Centrelink Statement of Income
- When can I expect to hear back from the Union regarding my application?

Applications are assessed every week and waiting time might be extended if we need to obtain extra documents from you.

Payments are made every Thursday following approval and could take up to 3 business days to process.

- How much can I expect to receive from the Bursary Program?

The Union gives out up to \$1000 for each bursary. However, the bursary amount will be assessed based on the information and documents you provide us in your application.
